## HT2024 Prognosis<sup>1</sup>

## Background

This time compensation prognosis is in line with the “Guide on Time Compensation” decided in February 2018 by the PhD Chapter Board that can be found in Annex 1 of the decision [Dr2019-CP-02/0002](#) and subsequent others taken related to that matter, and also currently executed by request of THS and KTH.

The prognosis for the central and national level compensation, with a claiming plan, was previously discussed by the Chapter Board at the board meeting on 2024-02-01. The budget for school-level representation is governed by its own guidelines, where each Doctoral School Council took it as a foundation to report their own prognosis.

This prognosis is not final and will be adjusted and then claimed at the end of the semester, and this fact should be taken into account when using any data from it. The adjustment process can be either an increase or a decrease in the percentage time. In some cases, the time is subject to an increase when there is more ongoing work than initially foreseen, and a reduction can occur due to a notable absence from the Chapter or Council activities.

All the above-mentioned board members will also serve as Event Managers for the CBH PhD council. The Chairperson gets 15% time compensation owing to the amount of time dedicated to the planning and organisation of all meetings, documentation and participation in other council meetings such as quality council, school council, program council, department council, THS meetings and other duties.
